#### **Car Parking**

#### **Primary 1 Enrolments**

Children who reach 5 years of age on or before 21st August 2018 <u>must</u> commence primary education at the start of the school session in August 2018. Children whose fifth birthday falls on or between the 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2018 and 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019 <u>may</u> commence primary education in August 2018.

Where: St. Bernadette's Primary School When: Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2018 Time: 9am – 11.30am then 1.30pm to 3pm

What to bring: Birth Certificate, Baptism Certificate and Proof of Address, e.g. recent Utility Bill.

## **Primary & Secondary School Placing Requests**

Parents/Carers must submit a Placing Request if they wish their child:

- to attend a school other than their catchment area school
- to attend a denominational school and are not baptised Roman Catholic
- to transfer from a non-denominational primary school to a denominational secondary school or vice versa

Placing Requests are available from school or on <a href="https://www.falkirk.gov.uk">www.falkirk.gov.uk</a>. Forms must be returned to the Director of Children's Services at Sealock House no earlier than Thursday 7st December 2017 up to the 15th March 2018. Parents/Carers will be notified of the outcome in writing by 30th April 2018.

## **Parent Council Meeting**


