The event will begin with a short presentation in the hall and then you and your child will have the opportunity to be guided by our current S1 pupils round our school to visit different curricular areas and have the opportunity to see some exemplar learning experiences showcased by our wonderful S1 pupil ambassadors. Thursday 1st February – pupils only

All P7 pupils will attend St Mungo's HS on Thursday 1st February with their primary schools. We will celebrate Mass together and then take part in a range of learning experiences based around our focus of 'Serving the common good' as part of Catholic Education week. P7 pupils will have an earlier interval and lunch to aid their transition. There are £2.00 meal deals available for primary pupils to pay that morning or pupils can bring a packed lunch. Children who are entitled to free school meals will have their meals provided here. Pupils can bring their own snack or pay cash if they wish to buy a snack at the canteen during morning interval. Please note that fizzy juice is not allowed at St Mungo's.

Pupils should not bring any valuables with them during the visit. This is a chance for them to chat and play and get to know their new classmates.
