# Here are some suggestions from the Salvation Army for different age ranges

- 0-3: dolls, teddy bears, cot mobiles, baby clothes, bath toys, CDs of suitable music and nursery rhymes, puzzles.
- **3-5**: dolls and action figures, cars, lorries, DVDs and CDs (music and nursery rhymes), colouring sets, pencils, crayons, books, puzzles.
- **5-9**: educational games and toys, stationery (colouring sets, pencils, crayons, school sets.) CDs and family friendly DVDs, books, puzzles, word search, crosswords.
- 9-12: games and toys, stationery, CDs, DVDs, books, T-shirts, hair accessories, gloves scarves, hats.
- **13-16**: CDs, DVDs, Vouchers, books, make-up and toiletries (please try to ensure non-allergic ingredients if possible), gloves, scarves, hats, T-Shirts, hair accessories.
