Step 2:

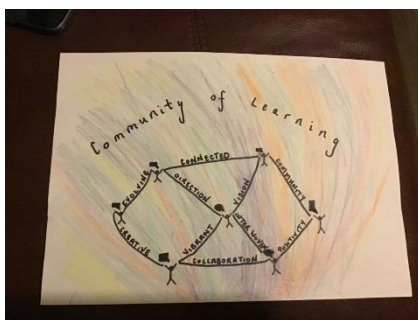
Illustrate each word. This might be hand drawn from your imagination or use the internet to find illustrations. For example:

With values we all blossom together.

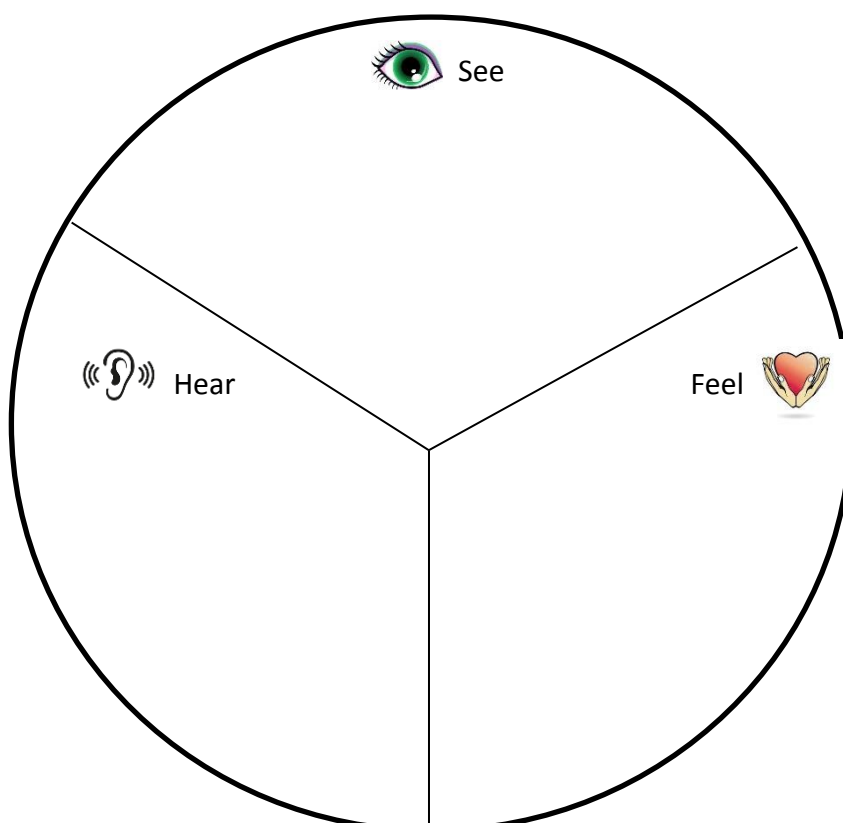
Step 1:
