Signing into nursery

Can all children please be signed into the nursery when they are dropped off. Please write down who is collecting them and what time they will be collected at. This is to ensure their safety.

Library visits

After we return from the Easter Holiday, we will be visiting the local library. Each group will



take it in turns to go with their key worker.

Children should come to the nursery as normal and staff will get them ready to go to the library once all the children are in and settled.

Health Checks

Please remember it is Falkirk Council Policy that a child **should not return** to school or nursery until they are 48 hours clear of any sickness / diarrhoea illness.



Regular checks for Head Lice are always recommended.

We still have cases of Chickenpox being reported in the nursery. Please be mindful about sending your child when they are unwell as they can be unwell before theirs spots appear.

Staff Training

Mrs Kinnaird and Mrs Armstrong have Sighted Guide Training on Thursday to support those with visual impairments.



Clothing

Please ensure your child has at least one change of clothes in their nursery bag in case they need changed during the nursery session.

Can all clothing please have your child's name clearly labelled on their clothes items.

Walks around the community

Staff will be going on local walks around the community over the next few weeks to look for 'signs of Spring', so please ensure your child has waterproof clothes and wellies that can be kept at nursery to allow them to participate in these walks.



Outdoor Learning

At St. Bernadette's ELC Class we pride ourselves on being an outdoor nursery and try to provide our children with access to outdoors for most of the session. We ask that all children have appropriate outdoor clothing as we are out in <u>ALL</u> weathers – Wellington boots, waterproof jacket and waterproof trousers - which can be left at nursery.

If your child is unwell the best place for them is at home. We cannot ensure children stay inside when recovering from illness as we are an outdoor nursery and children spend a large part of their day outdoors.

If your child is not well enough to go outdoors, then they should not be in nursery.

Makaton

The children will be introduced to Makaton over the next few weeks.

Makaton is a unique language programme that uses symbols, signs and speech to enable people to communicate. It supports the development of essential communication skills such as attention and listening, comprehension, memory, recall and organisation of language and expression.

Ask your child if they can remember the signs we learned on Wednesday ...
