Sun Cream

Please can you check the weather and apply sun cream before your child comes to ELC when appropriate. Staff will have

Sun cream will be reapplied in the afternoon by staff, so if do not wish your child to have ELC cream applied, please hand in a bottle with your child's name to staff.

Appropriate Clothing

Please ensure that your child has appropriate clothing for nursery in the warmer weather such as clothes that cover their shoulders (not strappy tops) and dressed in long sleeved tops or loose cotton clothing.



As the weather is getting warmer over the next couple of months, we ask that you provide your child with a sun hat which can be kept at nursery.

Please make sure your <u>child's name is on these items</u>. It would also be helpful if you could make sure there is at least one change of clothes in your child's nursery bag.

If your child borrows nursery clothes, could these please be returned once your child has finished with them.

We also ask that your child has their own pair of wellie boots and waterproofs which can be kept at nursery.

Lending Library

Can all the lending library books please be brought back before the Easter holidays so Sarah can update the books we have. Thank you.

Health Checks

Please remember it is <u>Falkirk Council</u>

<u>Policy</u> that a child should not return to school or nursery until they are 48 hours clear of any sickness / diarrhoea illness.

(for example if your child was last sick at 7.30pm on a Saturday night, they are 48 hours clear on Monday at 7.30pm and can therefore return on the Tuesday, if they feel well within themselves)

Regular checks for Head Lice are always recommended.

If your child requires medicine to treat an infection (antibiotics), please speak to Cat who will be happy to assist with this. However, should your child require Calpol and/or has a high temperature, we would ask you to support us with managing any outbreaks of illness that they stay home from nursery. Calpol can mask a high temperature which in turn makes it difficult for us to monitor any illness and spread of infection. We hope you understand and support us with these measures as they are in place to protect all children and families.

If your child is unwell the best place for them is at home. We cannot ensure children stay inside when recovering from illness as we are an outdoor nursery and children spend a large part of their day outdoors.

If your child is not well enough to go outdoors, then they should not be in nursery.


